World-Class Curriculum

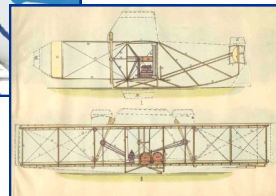
Courses include both high school-level introductory classes and Embry-Riddle college courses. Business partners provide opportunities for students to understand the relevance between education and work-based needs.
