Employment of Non-Degreed Vocational and Adult Instructional Personnel	6.172
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1. Part-time and Full-time Non-degreed Teachers of Career Programs. Qualifications for non-degreed teachers of career and technical education courses are based primarily on successful occupational experience rather than academic training.
2. Qualifications. Qualifications for such teachers are:
 - a. The filing of a complete set of fingerprints in the same manner as required by Florida Statute 1012.32.
 - b. Documentation of education and successful occupational experience including documentation of:
 - i. A high school diploma or the equivalent.
 - ii. Completion of six (6) years of full-time successful occupational experience or the equivalent of part-time experience in the teaching specialization area. The School Board may establish alternative qualifications for teachers with an industry certification in the career area in which they teach.
 - iii. Completion of career education training conducted through the local school district inservice master plan.
 - iv. For full-time teachers, completion of professional education training in teaching methods, course construction, lesson planning and evaluation, and teaching special needs students. This training may be completed through coursework from an accredited or approved institution or an approved district teacher education program.
 - v. Demonstration of successful teaching performance.
 - vi. Documentation of industry certification when state or national industry certifications are available and applicable.
