

MINUTES
School Board Workshop
June 25, 2013

This workshop, held at the St. Johns County School Board Administrative Center, 40 Orange Street, St. Augustine, Florida, was called to order at 8:31 a.m. by Chairman Tommy Allen. Dr. Joseph Joyner called roll; school board members, Mr. Tommy Allen, Mr. Bill Mignon, Mr. Bill Fehling, Mrs. Beverly Slough and Mr. Patrick Canan were present. Also in attendance were School Board Attorney Frank D. Upchurch, III, district staff, and media representatives.

Opening Comments

Mrs. Slough stated that there was a chart on charter schools published in the Wall Street Journal showing that public schools are doing better than charter schools. Dr. Joyner stated that there would be an update on school grades soon. Dr. Joyner also stated that there are seventeen changes to school grading this year that include a rise in writing scoring from 3 to 3.5, increase in cut scores, and change in middle school End-of-Course Exams (EOC).
