Guidelines:

- Open to all students in grades K-12. Elementary, Middle and High School art are judged separately.
- Entries must be originals of the student artist- do not use copyrighted materials and/or designs.
- Poster submissions should be no smaller than 8 ½ by 11 inches and no larger than 11 by 14 inches.
- Suggested mediums are as follows: crayon, ink, paint, markers, photography or digital media.
- All submissions must be two-dimensional.
- Keep with the positive theme. **Do NOT** include the Crime Stoppers logo.
- Do NOT include images of guns, killing or drug paraphernalia in the artwork.
- Adhere to the Student Code of Conduct and Dress Code.
- Please encourage students to use bright colors, which reproduce better then pastel colors.
- Attach the below entry form to the back of each student's art submission. Entries without completed, attached forms will be disqualified. Print neatly.

Awards: \$100.00- First Place \$50.00 - Second Place \$25.00 - Third Place

Each artist will receive a certificate. Cash awards will be presented to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners in each division (Elementary, Middle and High), totaling in nine winners. The nine winners from Volusia, Flagler, Putnam and St. Johns counties will then be judged at the 7th Judicial circuit level. Each school division will have one overall winner.

The three overall winners will receive an additional \$300.00. Their posters will be reprinted and placed in every school in the four-county circuit, at the appropriate grade levels.

- Originality and Creativity
- Aesthetic Quality
