St Johns County School District Head Start program provides free pre-school and comprehensive health and social services to low-income 3 and 4 year old children and their families living in St. Johns County.

Please complete the application form completely and accurately. All information will be kept strictly confidential. It will be used to help us to determine whether or not your family is eligible for Head Start and to prioritize your application. If you need assistance in completing the application you may contact the Head Start office at 547-4896.

Applications will only be processed if required documents are provided along with the completed application. Required documents:

Certified Birth Certificate	Available at Office of Vital Statistics at St. Johns County Health Department. <i>To be eligible for Head Start your child must be at least three or four years of age on or before September 1, 2011.</i>
Two Proofs of Residence	Acceptable documents: driver's license, utility bills, lease or rental agreement
Income	Proof of income for year 2010 OR previous twelve months. W2, Tax Record, Benefits Award Letter, Pay Stubs, Employer Verification.
Photo Identification	Photo ID of the legal Parent/Guardian is required.

The following information may be helpful to you in completing the application:

General Information: Only a parent or legal guardian may sign this application. We must be able to reach you in order to enroll your child. If you move or change your phone number after completing this application it is your responsibility to notify the St. Johns County Head Start Office.

Income: Income and the information provided must prove your household income from the 2010 calendar year or the past twelve months. We will assist you to determine which will best show your family's need. If you are receiving TANF, SSI, or Foster Care benefits you are income eligible for Head Start; however, documentation of that benefit is required.

Priority: Head Start does not process applications on a first come – first served basis. The information you provide on this application will determine your child's placement on the selection list.

Enrollment: Initial selection occurs June 1st. Applications received prior to that date are considered for initial enrollment. Applications received after July 1st will be placed on the Head Start waiting list.
