Applications for the 2011-2012 ILC Leadership Academy will be accepted August 8 – September 9. Your application packet should include:

- Application form
- Verification of at least three years teaching experience
- Completion of the at least two reading competencies, CAR-PD, or NGCAR-PD
- Letter of recommendation from your most recent principal or supervisor emphasizing your skills as a teacher, and your potential ability for leading teachers
- Copy of your St. Johns County professional in-service record
- Written document explaining your perception of the role an ILC serves in a school

The ILC Leadership Academy cohort will receive training, 4 – 6 p.m., once monthly, at 40 Orange Street. The content of these sessions will be very similar to that of current ILCS. It will include the Just Read Florida! coaching model, Marzano, text complexity, writing, Common Core State Standards, and more. In addition to preparing you for the future, this cohort will help you be more successful now!
