A postsecondary employment training program for *students with disabilities who have completed high school graduation requirements*. It is targeted for individuals whose goal is *competitive employment*. SEARCH St. Johns will take place during the course of the 2017-2018 school year at the **Renaissance World Golf Village Resort, St. Augustine**. Students will participate in three internships while immersed in the hotel business to learn essential employability skills.
