

New K-8 Academy to Open for the 2019 – 2020 SY

Mill Creek Elementary School is currently being converted into a K-8 Facility. The conversion includes a 37,388 s.f., 19-classroom building addition and a 22,782 s.f. gymnasium building. The project is designed by SchenkelShultz Architecture and is being constructed by W & J Construction Corporation. The Project is planned to open for the 2019 – 2020 School Year.

Palm Valley Academy

Palm Valley Academy (temporarily named K-8 School “KK”) opened to students for the 2018 – 2019 SY. This school was built to relieve overcrowding in North Eastern St. Johns County. Palm Valley Academy has capacity for approximately 1,496 students. This school was partially funded by the Half-Cent Sales Surtax approved by voters in 2015. The project was designed by Harvard Jolly Architecture and constructed by Charles Perry Partners, Inc. and achieved a successful school opening on August 10, 2018.



Freedom Crossing Academy

Freedom Crossing Academy (temporarily named K-8 School “LL”) opened to students for the 2018 – 2019 SY. This school was built to relieve overcrowding in North Western St. Johns County. FCA has capacity for approximately 1,496 students. This school was fully funded by the Half-Cent Sales Surtax approved by voters in 2015. Freedom Crossing Academy has been constructed to standards qualifying it to function as a Special Needs Hurricane Shelter. The project was designed by Harvard Jolly Architecture and constructed by AFL Construction, LLC and achieved a successful school opening on August 10, 2018.
