

Shelter Retrofit Projects: Switzerland Point and Pacetti Bay Middle Schools

Switzerland Point and Pacetti Bay Middle Schools are currently equipped to serve as emergency shelters for St. Johns County residents. The Florida Department of Emergency Management has identified these schools for retrofit projects to add additional shelter capacity to each school. The School District is executing shelter retrofit upgrades and will complete the work in the Fall of 2019. The school district will be fully reimbursed for these upgrades by the State of Florida.

Liberty Pines Academy Classroom Addition

A classroom addition project is in the design phase for Liberty Pines Academy. Harvard Jolly Architecture is the selected design firm with the design being accomplished through a reuse contract. The Liberty Pines Classroom Addition project is planned for a 2020-2021 school year opening.

Mill Creek Academy K-8 Conversion, Dining Addition and Remodel

Mill Creek Academy continues its conversion into a K-8 Facility. The conversion includes a 37,388 s.f., 19-classroom building addition and a 22,782 s.f. gymnasium building. The project is designed by SchenkelShultz Architecture and is being constructed by W & J Construction Corporation. The remodel of the media center, administration and kitchen areas as well as a dining expansion at MCA was also designed by SchenkelShultz Architecture and is being executed by E. Vaughn Rivers, Inc. through a Construction Management Continuing Services Contract. The completion of the Mill Creek K-8 Academy Conversion project, Dining Expansion and Remodel work is scheduled for a 2019-2020 school year opening.
