
## Using HAC with an iPad/Tablet

When viewing Home Access Center with a tablet, we have noticed that the Classwork option can be difficult to view.


By default, all courses and all classwork are set to show. On a PC, you can use the scrollbar to view all the items. However, on a tablet, there are no scrollbars. The tablet screen currently only shows you what will fit onto your tablet screen.

We have submitted this to the software vendor to correct. In the meantime, we do have a partial workaround.


On the right hand side of the page, there is an option that will show either Collapse All or Expand All.



If you click Collapse All, you will be shown a list of all courses your student is taking, with no detail.



If you click on the option, you will be shown the coursework just for that class.



You will still be limited by the amount of detail that can fit on the tablet screen. You will be able to see less detail for your child's  $6^{th}$  or  $7^{th}$  period than for their  $1^{st}$  or  $2^{nd}$  period class. You can get a little more room by using the **Show** option to limit the classes being shown on screen.



Again, this is not an ideal solution, and we have asked the vendor to fix this issue. We thank you for your patience.
