Pre-School for All Enrollment is open for the 2017-2018 School Year



Fun Summer Activities for Preschoolers!

Here is a list of summer activities that are low cost or free, but allow families to spend quality time together.

- Sprinkler Day—Have everyone get in bathing suits and play in the sprinkler.
- 2. Go to "story time" at the library—The local library branches have story time and other children's activities throughout the summer months. Or you can just take your kids and read or check out books.
- 3. Set up a lemonade stand—This is a great idea to get the neighborhood kids working together and to learn how to make and manage money.
- 4. Make homemade play-doh—Or buy some play-doh at the store if you can't make it.
- 5. Build a "fort" in the living room—Use giant cardboard boxes or throw a large sheet or blanket over a few kitchen chairs.
- Create a "mini-me"- Find a piece of large poster board or large heavy-duty paper wide enough for the kids to lay down on. Trace their entire bodies and let your kids decorate it to look like themselves.
- 7. Visit the Castillo De' San Marcos, Historic St. George St., Fountain of Youth, Fort Moses, St. Augustine Beach Pier, Washington Oaks, Princess Park, Treaty Park, or one of St. Augustine's beautiful beaches. These are all free or almost free for kids under 5!
- 8. Plant an herb garden.
- 9. Read books under the covers with a flash light.
- 10. Teach your child to fish.
