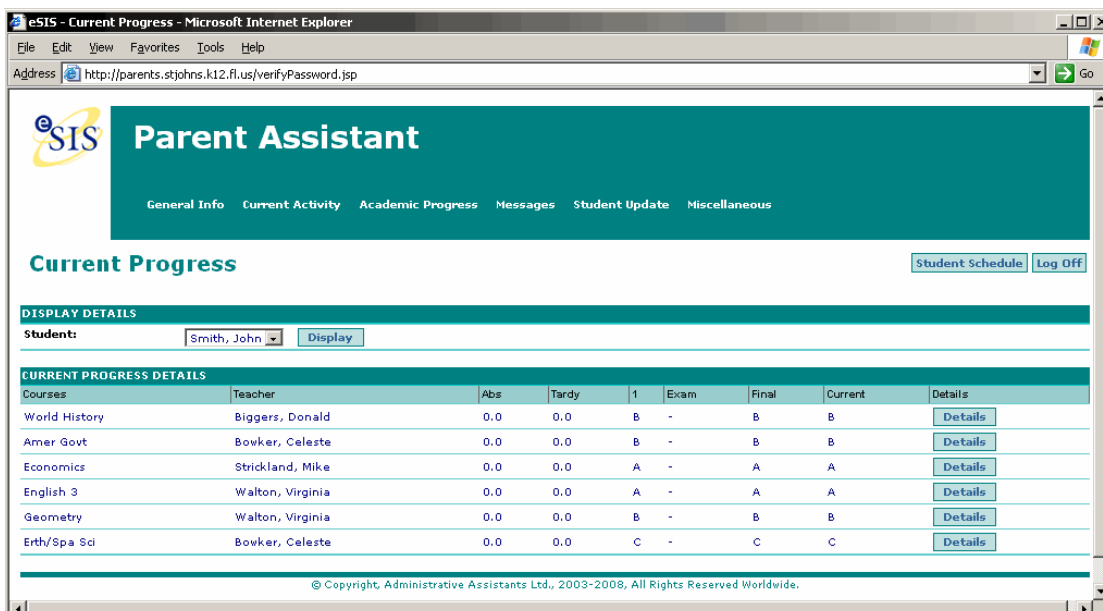
St. Johns County School District is implementing a new service starting in September 2008 to parents of children attending any of the District’s High and Middle Schools. This service is enabled by a new web-based application called Parent Assistant that will allow parents to view their child’s educational information. High schools will offer this program to parents wishing to use this communication tool. We plan to offer Parent Assistant to other district schools in the future.

Features:

Parent Assistant (PA) allows parents to view a host of educational data. For some data elements, parents will be able to make changes or request changes. Parents using PA will be able to see:

- Students’ schedule of classes
- Homework assignments, tests and grades
- Current progress in each class
- Credits earned toward graduation
- Detailed attendance information
- Emergency contacts, along with primary and secondary alert phone numbers on file
- Check non-school days for the year when planning vacations
- Important messages from teachers and administration
- Submit course requests (possible future implementation)

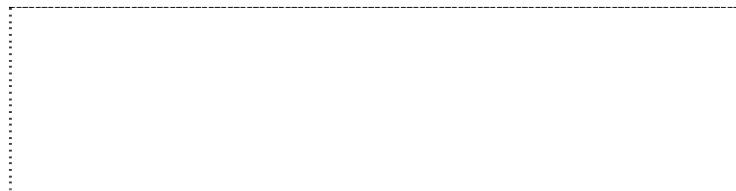
Here is a sample eSIS screen of a student’s current progress:



System Access and Support:

Each high and middle school will provide participating parents with this program introduction letter that contains their Username and Password to access Parent Assistant from home using the Internet. These web-based documents are designed to answer most questions on how to access the website, provide general system requirements and provide some typical troubleshooting suggestions.

Parent Responsibilities:

Each participating parent or guardian will be responsible for the following:

1. To safeguard their system account Username and Password
2. Notify their school immediately if their Username and Password is lost or compromised
3. Provide all necessary equipment to access the Internet (computer, Internet connection, Internet Explorer software, etc.)
4. Read the FAQ's and Parent Assistant Instruction Guide located on the District website
