STUDENT AWARDS:

- \$100. First Place Winner in Middle High School Division
- \$100. First Place Winner in High School Division
- (\$50 to the 2nd Place Winners and \$25 to the 3rd Place Winners in each division)

All nine of the division winners from Volusia, Flagler, Putnam and St. Johns Counties will be judged and an overall circuit winner for each school level will be selected. The three overall winners will receive an additional \$300 and their poster will be reprinted and posted in every school in the four-county circuit, at the appropriate grade levels.

CONTEST GUIDELINES:

1. Entries must be original works by students. Use of copyrighted materials and designs are prohibited.
2. Poster submissions should be **no smaller than 8 1/2 x 11 inches** and **no larger than 11 x 14 inches** in size. Suggested mediums are crayon, pastel, ink, paint or markers. All submissions must be two-dimensional works. Posters may include original designs, short slogans and phrases related to the theme.
3. A completed entry form must accompany each entry and be attached to back of entry. Entries without completed, attached forms will be disqualified.
