What is an Endorsement?

An Endorsement is an add-on to a teaching certificate that meets the requirements set forth by the State to serve a specific population of students. In Florida, the three most common Endorsements include:

ESOL

Reading

Gifted

ESOL

ESOL, or English for Speakers of Other Languages, is required of any teacher of ELA. Though the full endorsement or certification is not required of ALL teachers, ALL teachers do have at least one course they must take in the state of Florida.
