



St. Augustine Youth Services presents the Mobile Crisis Response Team (MCRT)

The Mobile Crisis Response Team (MCRT) provides on-site risk assessments to students in St. Johns County with Behavioral Health needs. MCRT operates on weekdays from Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday, 8:30am to 5pm, and Wednesday 8am-3pm. The team consists of Licensed Mental Health Counselors experienced in the assessment and treatment of youth with mental health issues, a Registered Nurse and a certified Targeted Case Manager experienced with coordinating wrap-around services to youth.

Services offered:

1. Onsite Immediate Behavioral Health Needs Assessment by a licensed mental health counselor, including initiating a Baker Act if indicated.
2. Communication regarding outcome of Needs Assessment and recommendations to school personnel and family members.
3. Access to individual and family counseling.
4. Access to targeted case management services coordinating both medical and behavioral health needs.
5. Nurse consultation for medical issues.
6. Connect families with community providers.
