

MINUTES
School Board Workshop
August 26, 2014

This workshop, held at the St. Johns County School Board Administrative Center, 40 Orange Street, St. Augustine, Florida, was called to order at 8:30 a.m. by Chairman Bill Mignon. Dr. Joyner called roll; school board members, Mrs. Beverly Slough, Mr. Patrick Canan, Mr. Bill Mignon and Mr. Tommy Allen were present. Bill Fehling was absent.
