Mrs. Sweeny detailed Amendment 2, Veterans Disabled Due to Combat Injury; Homestead Property Tax Discount; Amendment 3, State Government Revenue Limitation; Amendment 4, Property Tax Limitations; Property Value Decline; Reduction for Nonhomestead Assessment Increases; Delay of Scheduled repeal; Amendment 8, Religious Freedom; Amendment 9, Homestead Property Tax Exemption for Surviving Spouse of Military Veteran or First Responder; Amendment 10, Tangible Personal Property Tax Exemption; and Amendment 11, Additional Homestead Exemption; Low-income Seniors who Maintain Long-Term Residency on Property; Equal to Assessed Value

Legislative Platform

Mrs. Sweeny presented a draft legislative platform for the 2013 session for the St. Johns County School District. Discussion followed.

McKinney Vento Homeless Assistance Act
