SERVICES OFFERED



Completion of initial interview and assessment of current symptoms to provide education, identify risk factors for prolonged recovery, and ensure individual receives all appropriate treatments. Comprehensive Neuropsychological testing when indicated



PHYSIATRIST

Consult with our PM&R Physician is available if there is no physician involved in the patient care or the referring physician wishes that our program physician take over the management of the case



SCHOOL RE-ENTRY COORDINATION

Works as a liaison between the patient, families, school, and Brooks Rehabilitation to ensure appropriate school services and accommodations are received and implemented



PHYSICAL THERAPY

Evaluation and Treatment of headaches, neck pain, dizziness, and balance issues



OPTOMETRY / VISION THERAPY

Evaluation and Treatment of visual complaints including but not limited to light sensitivity, headaches, blurred vision, and difficulty reading



OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY

Assessment of issues related to activities of daily living and issuing of adaptive equipment if needed



SPEECH LANGUAGE PATHOLOGY

Evaluation and Treatment of reading, comprehension, writing, and language deficits



RETURN TO PLAY

Assist with completion of state required protocol and paperwork (AT 18 Form) to ensure athletes are safe and ready to return to their specific sports



DRIVING EVALUATION

Evaluates the driving safety of established and first time drivers who may have developmental, cognitive and disabling injuries while equipment, training lessons and independent driving recommendations are made



PSYCHOLOGY

Evaluation and treatment of coping and emotional difficulties, pain, and sleep problems that sometimes occur after injury
