- Students must participate in a hands-on interview process/skills assessment

- Students will be notified regarding acceptance by April 24th, 2020
- By applying to Project SEARCH, the adult student/guardian is agreeing that the student is ready for employment training. The end goal of Project SEARCH is job PLACEMENT and to transition to adult services, therefore ending deferment and all ESE/Transition/Related services from the school district by accepting receipt of the standard diploma
