

Reproductive Health Curriculum

Reproductive health is required instruction and will be taught during quarter four in 7th grade science classes over the course of no more than two class periods. In accordance with the Florida Department of Education guidelines, St. Johns County curriculum teaches “awareness of the benefits of sexual abstinence as the expected standard, and the consequences of teenage pregnancy.”

Curriculum topics include life goals, decision making skills, sexually transmitted disease symptoms and prevention (abstinence).
