Effective Advocacy Strategies

- In person visits.
- Individualized letters, emails, social media posts and phone calls.
- Personal stories.
- Local impact.
- •Attend events.
- School visits/ Newsletters.

Tips for Talking

•Be Prepared!

Be brief and organized - Avoid using "educationese" Keep handouts to one page.

- •Be Well Timed!
- •Be a Teacher!

Give specifics on how issues affect your school. Use real-life, local examples.

- •Be Actual and Factual!
- •Be Specific and Well Aimed!

Target the right person and tell them exactly what you would like them to do on an issue or bill.

•Be Positive!

Do not engage in angry retorts.

•Be a Resource!

Offer to help and provide information.

•Be Thankful!

Remember to thank Legislators & their staff for their time &service, both when you leave, & with a note.
