Consult the <u>Student Handbook</u> for clarification on specific fields in the application and for a helpful checklist of deadlines on the last 2 pages of the handbook.

- 1. Social Security Number (SSN) Even though it is not a required field, it is beneficial to complete this as it is easier to locate your application if there is an issue.
- 2. First Name & Last Name- needs to match high school transcript and test scores
- 3. Date of Birth Be sure to enter a 4 digit year
- 4. HS Graduation Date- see your school counselor
- 5. Phone Number Even though it is not a required field, it is beneficial to complete this as it is easier to locate your application if there is an issue. Check the box if you'd like to receive text alerts from OSFA if you supplied a cell phone number.
- 6. E-mail address This is where your login and password will be sent
- 7. Guilty of a felony charge- SAY NO UNLESS YOU WERE CONVICTED OF AN ADULT FELONY
- 8. Will you graduate or have graduated from a Florida high school, Home School, or with a GED? Yes
- 9. Have you previously completed a baccalaureate degree prior to the upcoming fall term? No
- 10. High School Graduation Date See your school counselor
- 11. Click "Submit" ONE TIME ONLY
- 12. Print copy of "Saved Results" page if you can.
