Tidbits from Tina

Hi my name is Tina Larson and I am the Mental Health Consultant for Head Start. I have the honor of visiting the Head Start classes on a rotation every month. Head Start children are fun and full of energy. My goal is to assist the children in learning about feelings, emotions, and using appropriate behaviors. Feelings and behaviors have a connection. It is my hope that you will read and implement these helpful hints.

When young children are worried, sad, or angry, it can be hard to:

Make friends, follow directions, express feelings or wishes, pay attention in class and solve problems in a positive way

Things you can do and say to help your child:

- 1. Maké sure they always féel safe. "I know loud noises can be scary. It is okay and I am here with you."
- 2. Offer choices. "Do you want the blue shirt or the red shirt?"
- 3. Practice patience. "Let's wait until the song is over and then we will go outside."
- 4. Show understanding. "You REALLY want another cookie. It is hard when you can only have one."
- 5. Practice following directions. "First pick up the blocks and then pick up the cars."
- **6**. Praise your child when she keeps trying. "İ love the way you keep trying to find the right piece of the puzzle."
- 7. Play together at least 15 minutes a day. "We are so busy today, but it is important for us to play together for a little while".
