What should I expect of my school?

- Daily assignments posted in Schoology
- Online instructional resources/textbook access
- Regular communication with teachers, teachers will work with families to determine the best modality (Schoology, email, phone)
- Support for students who have questions or need assistance
- Student is considered present when quarantined unless sick and unable to continue with their education.

What does my school expect of me?

- Complete daily work, submit work per established mode (Schoology, paper-based)
- Ask for assistance from the teacher or support personnel as needed
- Participate in teacher check-in through agreed upon mode: phone, email, or Schoology
