Throughout the school year there will be varied opportunities to attend workshops or other learning opportunities that may count towards the 20 SWD points needed to renew your teaching certificate. The quick way to tell if the learning opportunity counts is to look at the Course Name which is a 7-Digit number. If the 7-Digit number is followed by an E, then the course counts.

The BESE (Bureau of Exceptional Student Education) of Florida Department of Education work through FDLRS to offer courses delivered through the PDA Portal (Professional Development Alternatives).
