Safeschools is a Professional Learning Depository filled with various “courses” that all SJCS D employees may take for free.

In order to earn inservice points / credit for the courses outside of the annual courses we MUST complete each year, you must complete an entire “module” and upload the certificates of completion to the PD Department using BusinessPlus.

These courses are available to any SJCS D employee who would like to extend their learning in any of these areas.

How to earn credit:

***Please Note: You can only earn credit ONCE for these courses. You may NOT repeat them annually.*

1. Choose a “module” to complete
2. Complete each “course” within the “module” and save each certificate of completion
 - a. Save the certificates as one document on your computer
 - b. Title the Document with your E#, Name, and the Module Name
3. Login to BusinessPlus
4. Go to Professional Development
5. Click on Upload Files
6. Upload the document to PDA/FDLRS/BEES S_Certificates_of_Completion
7. Allow up to a month for points to appear on your transcript
