## INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

Vendors are required to provide a certificate(s) evidencing, at a minimum, the Certificate of Insurance requirements below. Additional lines of insurance and/or increased limits may be required depending on the good/service provided.

<u>Commercial General Liability:</u> Commercial General Liability insurance including products and completed operations and contractual liability, arising from any and all claims for property damage and bodily injury, including death, in the amounts listed below. The School Board of St. Johns County, Florida, must be listed as an Additional Insured and Certificate Holder on the certificate of insurance.

Workers' Compensation/Employer's Liability: All non-construction contractors and vendors that have one or more employees or subcontracts any portion of their work to another individual or company are required to have Workers' Compensation insurance. For contracts of \$25,000 or more, no State of Florida, Division of Workers' Compensation, Exemption forms will be accepted. All contractors engaging in construction-related activities, as defined by 440.02(10) Florida Statutes, are required to have Workers' Compensation insurance. All entities and individuals required to have Workers' Compensation insurance must purchase a commercial Workers' Compensation insurance policy to the limits listed below. The Workers' Compensation policy must be endorsed to waive the insurer's right to subrogate against the School Board of St. Johns County, Florida.
