History of St. Augustine, "The Nation's Oldest City"

- St. Augustine was founded in 1565, by Spanish explorer Pedro Menéndez de Avés.
- The city was attacked twice in 1586, by English corsair Sir Francis Drake who burned the city down, and again in 1668, by pirate Captain John Davis who killed 60 residents.
- The settlers stayed anyway and rebuilt the city.
- American tycoon and railroad developer, Henry Flagler, truly put St. Augustine on the map. In the late 19th century, he built two extravagant hotels, the Alcazar (now the Lightner Museum and City Hall) and Hotel Ponce de León (now Flagler College) in an effort to lure the wealthy to travel here in the warmer months on his railroad.
- In 1914 Engineers Henry Holland Buckman and George A. Pritchard found several industrial minerals on the beaches, including 2 that are used in the production of titanium, harvested for use in World War I. These beaches are now known as Ponte Vedra Beach.
- Saint Johns County is home to THE PLAYERS, PGA TOUR Headquarters Association of Tennis Professionals (ATP) Americas Headquarters and the World Golf Hall of Fame.
- More than 1.3 million people live in Northeast FL. We have a culturally diverse workforce of about 750,000 with a median age of 37.
