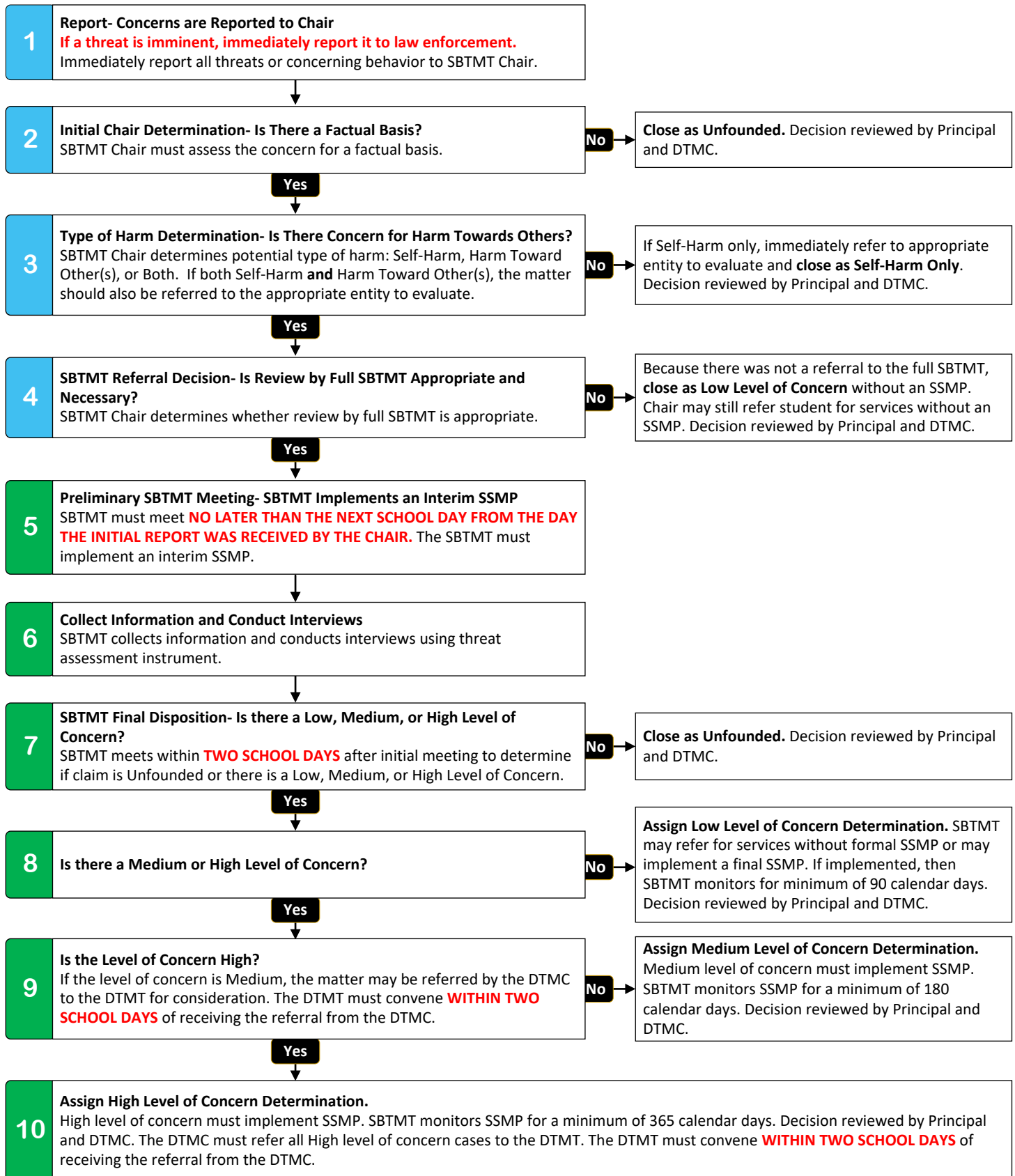


Florida Harm Prevention and Threat Management Workflow

The primary goal of all school safety efforts is to prevent violence or harm to members of the school community. Effective threat management is the single greatest opportunity to prevent a school attack. The threat management process is a systematic, fact-based method designed to first identify whether behaviors and/or communications constitute a concern for violence or harm to another person. This flowchart is not all encompassing but should act as an aid for members to effectively work through the process of threat management.
