STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES (SWD) GROWTH

Measurable Outcome: Increase SWD proficiency by at least 2 percentage points, targeting above 55% in ELA, 51% in Math, and 30% in Science.

Action Steps:

- Analyze student data quarterly and provide inclusive scheduling and support.
- Use PLCs to align standards, analyze data, and create flexible learning groups.
- Provide targeted Tier 2/NEST interventions while protecting core instruction.



COLLABORATIVE PLANNING & INSTRUCTIONAL PRACTICE

Measurable Outcome: Increase schoolwide proficiency by 2 percentage points to 83% in ELA, 75% in Math, and 68% in Grade 5 Science.

Action Steps:

- Use PLC data cycles to align standards, assessments, and instructional pacing.
- Provide daily NEST intervention/enrichment with targeted support.
- Partner with CAST specialists to strengthen differentiated, high-yield instruction.



POSITIVE CULTURE & ATTENDANCE

Measurable Outcome: Increase student, staff, and parent engagement while reducing chronic absenteeism and disciplinary suspensions.

Action Steps:

- Use assemblies/recognition programs to reinforce SOAR traits.
- Monitor attendance quarterly and provide mentoring for chronically absent students.
- Partner with PTO and community organizations to strengthen family engagement and positive behavior supports.
