ELA & MATH LEARNING GAINS AND PROFICIENCY

Measurable Outcome: Increase FAST proficiency by at least 2 percentage points to 91% in ELA and 87% in Math.

Action Steps:

- Provide common planning time for PLC collaboration and data-driven instruction.
- Use training and observations to ensure consistent PLC implementation.
- Monitor student growth data to provide timely interventions and address learning gaps.



COLLEGE & CAREER ACCELERATION

Measurable Outcome: Increase the college and career acceleration rate by at least 5 percentage points, from 76% to 81% or higher.

Action Steps:

- Expand AICE, CTE, and business acceleration pathways.
- Use performance data to identify students ready for accelerated coursework.
- Provide data-driven advising to align acceleration opportunities with student strengths and postsecondary goals.



STUDENT ATTENDANCE & CHRONIC ABSENTEEISM

Measurable Outcome: Increase daily attendance by 3%, reduce chronic absenteeism, and improve school climate and student connectedness.

Action Steps:

- Review attendance data weekly to identify and support at-risk students.
- Implement weekly "Check and Connect" mentoring and family partnerships.
- Evaluate attendance trends quarterly and adjust interventions as needed.



CELEBRATIONS & SUCCESSES

- **Best Buddies Excellence:** the largest club on campus, earned the Legacy Award for being Northeast Florida's top fundraiser for 10+ years, and placed 8th nationally in 2025 Friendship Walk fundraising.
- **AP Academic Excellence:** Named a 2025 Gold AP School Honor Roll school by the College Board, recognizing both strong AP participation and student success.
- **National FBLA Success:** five national FBLA winners in 2025, including 1st place nationally in Job Interview, 3rd in Computer Applications, and two Top-10 finishes in Cybersecurity.
- **Award-Winning Career Academies:** Creekside's ACE Mentor team won the 2025 national CIRT/ACE Design Competition for its "Bullard Project," while its CyberPatriots team earned 1st place in Florida's Platinum Division.
- **Championship Athletics:** Creekside's Girls Cross-Country team won a Florida State Championship, adding to the school's strong tradition of athletic success.
