## SIP AREAS OF FOCUS



### ESSA SUBGROUPS ACHIEVEMENT

**Measurable Outcome:** Increase achievement levels for SWD by 10% in ELA, and FRL and WHT by 10% in both math and ELA.

#### Action Steps:

- Provide Kagan training to strengthen student engagement.
- Utilize district ESE/Curriculum support for planning and data analysis.
- Provide ongoing classroom management and de-escalation training.
- Use DreamBox for targeted math remediation.



### POSITIVE BEHAVIOR INTERVENTION SYSTEM

**Measurable Outcome:** Continue to decrease high magnitude behaviors while increasing the number of students participating in PBIS.

#### Action Steps:

- Track involvement in the PBIS program through the store log and student data sheets.
- Conduct thorough tracking of Out of School Suspension (OSS) days to improve and monitor behaviors.
