PROGRAM EXPANSION

Measurable Outcome: Increase and expand current programs offered at the FCTC main campus.

Action Steps:

- Plan and develop an Applied Cybersecurity class.
- Expand Early Childhood Education to include dual-enrollment and post-secondary students.
- Implement and maintain an Evening Welding CTE Adult Course.
- Develop a new Surgical Technology program and a Central Sterile Processing program.



HASTINGS BRANCH CAMPUS

Measurable Outcome: Identify and develop a new FCTC affiliate campus in Hastings, Florida by 2028.

Action Steps:

- Renovate the former Hastings High School and construct a Technical Education Training Center.
- Implement Adult Education, Early Childhood, Cosmetology, and Health Science programs.
- Launch Diesel Systems Technician, Alternative Energy, and Marine Service Technology programs.



INDUSTRIAL & PUBLIC SAFETY

Measurable Outcome: Expand and upgrade Industrial and Public Safety campus programs.

Action Steps:

- Implement new Industrial Machinery Maintenance, Global Logistics, and CNC Production Specialist programs.
- Renovate apparatus bays, upgrade training equipment, and implement a new Drill Tower for Public Safety.
- Enhance Nursery Management and Landscape and Turf Management programs.

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PROFESSIONAL NURSING & HEALTH

Measurable Outcome: Develop and implement new pathways for nursing and health sciences.

Action Steps:

- Initiate a postsecondary Professional Nursing program (LPN-RN).
- Develop an alternate pathway PN program for working adults (nights/weekends).
- Change Dental Assisting to a Technology & Management program with expanded functions.

Measurable Outcome: Ensure continuous improvement of programmatic student outcomes data.

Action Steps:

- Monitor all COE approved programs' Completion, Placement, and Licensure (CPL) data against benchmarks.
- Identify strategies to increase industry certifications and licenses earned within each program.
- Support BOOST program for students with intellectual disabilities.
