SIP AREAS OF FOCUS



ELA LOWEST QUARTILE & SWD LEARNING GAINS

Measurable Outcome: Increase ELA learning gains for students in the bottom quartile by at least 15 percentage points by the end of 2026-27.

Action Steps:

- Use PLCs to analyze FAST, DIBELS, and assessment data to target instruction for bottom-quartile students and SWD.
- Provide literacy coaching to identify reading needs and adjust instructional strategies.
- Use protected NEST intervention time for targeted small-group support, monitoring data regularly to adjust interventions.



INSTRUCTIONAL PRACTICE: SCIENCE

Measurable Outcome: Increase 5th Grade Science proficiency by at least 15 percentage points by the end of 2026-27.

Action Steps:

- Collaborate with teacher leaders to identify essential Science standards across grade levels
- Use monthly HLC meetings to unpack and vertically align standards and analyze CSA data.
- Monitor implementation through classroom observations, HLC/PLC outcomes, and Science CSA data.



STUDENT ATTENDANCE & CHRONIC ABSENTEEISM

Measurable Outcome: Reduce chronic absenteeism by an additional 2 percentage points across Grades K-5 in 2026-27.

Action Steps:

- Use EWS data to identify students at risk for chronic absenteeism.
- Review attendance weekly and provide targeted family outreach.
- Use the 2x10 strategy to build supportive student-staff relationships.



CELEBRATIONS & SUCCESSES

Highlight key achievements, recognitions, programs, and milestones.

According to our 25-26 school data:

- Primary grades (K-2) increased their reading and math proficiency and exceeded target goals by up to 12%.
- Our SWD students increased their ELA proficiency by 12%.
- Our school reduced chronic absenteeism by 6.51%.

In the arts area:

- Four students were selected to represent Hickory Creek Elementary at All State in the areas of chorus and percussion.
