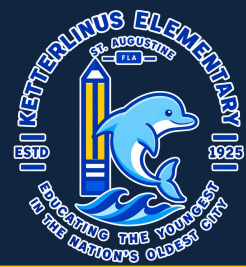

SWD SUBGROUP & MATH LOWEST QUARTILE GROWTH

Measurable Outcome: Increase SWD and Math L25 performance by at least 3%, ELA proficiency to 78%, Math proficiency to 83%, and Grade 3 ELA to 78%.

Action Steps:

- Use PLCs to analyze progress monitoring and CSA data.
- Provide flexible WIN intervention/enrichment while maintaining Tier 1 instruction.
- Monitor DreamBox usage and SWD growth to adjust supports.



SCIENCE INSTRUCTION & PROFICIENCY

Measurable Outcome: Increase Grade 5 Science proficiency from 66% to at least 69% through explicit, standards-based instruction in Grades 3-5.

Action Steps:

- Integrate science concepts and literacy through the Benchmark ELA curriculum.
- Monitor science instructional blocks to ensure Tier 1 standards coverage.
- Analyze science CSA data during PLCs to guide instruction.



POSITIVE CULTURE & ATTENDANCE (SWIM PROGRAM)

Measurable Outcome: Reduce chronic absenteeism by at least 10 students and out-of-school suspensions to 10 or fewer.

Action Steps:

- Use weekly MTSS meetings to monitor behavior and attendance trends.
- Reinforce SWIM expectations daily.
- Recognize positive behavior through incentives, awards, and family engagement.
