ESSA SUBGROUPS (SWD & ELL RECOVERY)

Measurable Outcome: Increase Grade 5 academic growth to 60% in ELA and 66% in Math, with ELL Reading and Math growth reaching at least 52%.

Action Steps:

- Review FAST and DIBELS data quarterly to adjust RtI supports.
- Use ESOL and progress-monitoring data to target language scaffolds and interventions.
- Provide data-driven small-group instruction for SWD and ELL skill gaps.



K-5 FOUNDATIONAL LITERACY & MATHEMATICS

Measurable Outcome: Achieve 75% Reading growth, 78% Math growth, and increase SWD growth to 60% or higher.

Action Steps:

- Use weekly PLC data reviews to analyze student performance and intervention effectiveness.
- Conduct monthly walkthroughs to strengthen Tier 1 Math and ELA instruction.
- Monitor SWD and struggling learners bi-weekly and adjust instruction promptly.



POSITIVE BEHAVIOR INTERVENTION SYSTEM (PBIS)

Measurable Outcome: Reduce out-of-school suspensions by 50%, from 72 to 36 or fewer, with Grade 7 suspensions decreasing from 26 to 8 or fewer

Action Steps:

- Implement schoolwide PBIS expectations with explicit monthly behavior lessons.
- Use positive reinforcement and CICO mentoring for Tier 2/3 students.
- Apply restorative and de-escalation strategies before out-of-school suspension.



STUDENT ATTENDANCE & CHRONIC ABSENTEEISM

Measurable Outcome: Reduce schoolwide chronic absenteeism from 18.7% to 10% or below, with K-2 decreasing from 23.7% to 12% or lower.

Action Steps:

- Monitor attendance weekly to identify students needing Tier 1-3 support.
- Conduct early family outreach to address barriers and create attendance plans.
- Use positive attendance incentives and family communication, with a K-2 focus
