ELA PROFICIENCY & GRADE 3 LITERACY

Measurable Outcome: Increase overall K-8 ELA proficiency by at least 2 percentage points and Grade 3 Reading proficiency from 84% to 87%

Action Steps:

- Use PLC data cycles to guide instructional adjustments.
- Monitor and strengthen high-yield small-group literacy instruction.
- Provide targeted Intensive Reading based on specific student skill needs.



MATHEMATICS PROFICIENCY & GROWTH

Measurable Outcome: Increase K-8 Math proficiency by at least 2 percentage points from 68% toward 72%.

Action Steps:

- Use PLC data cycles to monitor Math and FAST progress.
- Conduct walkthroughs to strengthen standards-aligned Math instruction.
- Provide targeted small-group interventions to address foundational skill gaps



SCIENCE INSTRUCTION & ACHIEVEMENT

Measurable Outcome: Increase overall Science proficiency by at least 2 percentage points, from 71% to 73% or higher.

Action Steps:

- Use PLC data reviews to align science instruction and pacing.
- Integrate literacy, vocabulary, and hands-on inquiry into science instruction.
- Monitor assessment data to provide timely, standards-based reteaching.

MIDDLE SCHOOL ACCELERATION

Measurable Outcome: Increase Middle School Math Acceleration participation and completion from 86% to 90%.

Action Steps:

- Use FAST scores, grades, and teacher recommendations to identify eligible students.
- Place Level 4–5 students in accelerated math coursework.
- Monitor progress and provide tutoring to support success in advanced courses.



STUDENT ATTENDANCE & POSITIVE CULTURE

Measurable Outcome: Increase student attendance from 93% to 96%, reduce chronic absenteeism below 1%, and strengthen student connectedness through PBIS

Action Steps:

- Reinforce Character Counts! and "The LPA Way" through monthly lessons.
- Monitor attendance monthly and provide targeted family outreach.
- Use PBIS incentives, recognition assemblies, and Wolf Warehouse rewards.



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
