INSTRUCTIONAL PRACTICE: ELA

Measurable Outcome: Increase Kindergarten ELA proficiency from 59% to 76% through targeted literacy instruction and ongoing data monitoring.

Action Steps:

- Strengthen Tier I literacy instruction using evidence-based, standards-aligned Science of Reading practices.
- Use FAST, formative, and classroom data to provide targeted small-group interventions and adjust instruction.
- Monitor instructional fidelity through walkthroughs, PLTs, coaching, and professional development.



STUDENT ATTENDANCE

Measurable Outcome: Reduce chronic absenteeism by 20%, from 142 students to 114 or fewer, by May 2027.

Action Steps:

- Review attendance data monthly to identify at-risk students and implement early interventions.
- Strengthen family communication to address attendance concerns and barriers.
- Implement attendance recognition, mentoring, and individualized supports to improve attendance.
