SIP AREAS OF FOCUS



SCIENCE INSTRUCTION & SUBGROUP GROWTH (SWD & BLACK STUDENTS)

Measurable Outcome: Increase overall Science achievement from 66% to 68% while narrowing achievement gaps for SWD and African American students.

Action Steps:

- Use FAST data to identify SWD and African American students needing science support.
- Maximize ESE support and co-teaching in 8th-grade science.
- Analyze CSA data quarterly to guide targeted reteaching.



MIDDLE SCHOOL MATHEMATICS ACCELERATION

Measurable Outcome: Increase middle school acceleration participation and completion from 80% to 90% or higher.

Action Steps:

- Identify all students scoring Level 3 or higher on FAST PM3 Reading and Math and automatically place them into advanced/accelerated math coursework.
- PLC teams and district CAST support track student performance on common assessments to deliver targeted tutoring prior to End-of-Course (EOC) exams.



SWD SUBGROUP ELA PROFICIENCY & GROWTH

Measurable Outcome: Increase SWD ELA proficiency from 30% to at least 35% while narrowing the 33-point achievement gap.

Action Steps:

- Maximize ESE support facilitation and co-teaching in ELA.
- Use FAST data to provide targeted small-group literacy interventions.
- Provide ongoing professional development on effective SWD instructional strategies.



STUDENT ATTENDANCE & POSITIVE CULTURE (PBIS)

Measurable Outcome: Reduce chronic absenteeism across Grades 6-8 and decrease out-of-school suspensions.

Action Steps:

- Reinforce positive behavior through the schoolwide Bark Bucks PBIS system.
- Review attendance and discipline data bi-weekly to identify students needing support.
- Provide mentoring and family outreach for chronically absent students.
