STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES (SWD)

Measurable Outcome: Increase ELA and Mathematics Learning Gains for the SWD subgroup by 2% (from 62% in ELA and 56% in Math).

Action Steps:

- Maximize IEP support through certified ELA and Math support facilitation.
- Use FAST data to target individual skill deficits and interventions.
- Provide ILC coaching and strategic scheduling, including Algebra 1 blocks.
- IEP and MTSS/RtI data every 6 weeks to adjust supports.



COLLEGE & CAREER ACCELERATION

Measurable Outcome: Increase College and Career Acceleration by 6 percentage points, from 84% to 90% for the 2026–27 cohort.

Action Steps:

- Monitor student participation in IB, AP, Dual Enrollment, and other acceleration pathways.
- Coordinate industry certification testing, preparation, and timely administration.
- Use certification results to provide targeted remediation and retake opportunities.
- Use data and strategic scheduling to ensure equitable access to acceleration programs.



STUDENT ATTENDANCE

Measurable Outcome: Reduce chronic absenteeism by 3%; increase student attendance by 3%.

Action Steps:

- Review EWS attendance data quarterly to identify at-risk students.
- Provide dean and counselor check-ins to address attendance barriers.
- Use schoolwide incentives to recognize consistent and improved attendance.
- Celebrate attendance gains through positive family outreach.
