MATHEMATICS LEARNING GAINS & LOWEST 25%

Measurable Outcome: Increase Math Learning Gains for the Lowest 25% from 59% to at least 61%, while improving overall Math Learning Gains across Grades 3–5

Action Steps:

- Provide push-in math tutoring and targeted small-group reteaching.
- Use PLC data cycles to identify gaps and develop deliberate practice plans.
- Deliver evidence-based math instruction with immediate feedback and academic vocabulary.



STUDENT ATTENDANCE & POSITIVE CULTURE

Measurable Outcome: Reduce chronic absenteeism by at least 3%, decreasing chronically absent students from 31 to 20 or fewer.

Action Steps:

- Monitor attendance weekly and provide early family outreach.
- Reinforce positive attendance through PBIS incentives and Otter Outpost rewards.
- Use counselor and community supports to address attendance barriers.



FOUNDATIONAL LITERACY & ELA GROWTH

Measurable Outcome: Maintain 89% ELA Achievement while increasing ELA Learning Gains from 76% toward 80%.

Action Steps:

- Use bi-weekly PLCs to analyze formatives and summatives.
- Provide scaffolded small-group instruction in phonics, vocabulary, and comprehension.
- Use reading tutors and intervention blocks to accelerate student growth.
