SIP AREAS OF FOCUS



7TH GRADE MATHEMATICS PROFICIENCY

Measurable Outcome: Increase FAST Math proficiency by at least 2% schoolwide, with targeted improvement in Grade 7 Math from 52% toward the district average.

Action Steps:

- Align Grade 7 Math pacing, curriculum, and essential standards through coaching and collaboration.
- Use assessment data to provide targeted small-group interventions.
- Provide job-embedded coaching and co-planning to strengthen Math instruction.



MIDDLE SCHOOL ACCELERATION

Measurable Outcome: Increase Middle School Acceleration participation from 83% to 90%, building on prior growth from 69%.

Action Steps:

- Use assessment data, grades, and recommendations to identify acceleration candidates.
- Provide proactive academic support and small-group tutoring.
- Monitor accelerated course performance quarterly and intervene early to support EOC success.



SWD SUBGROUP MATHEMATICS GROWTH

Measurable Outcome: Increase Math Learning Gains for SWD by 3 percentage points, raising proficiency from 44% to at least 47%.

Action Steps:

- Strengthen ESE and Gen Ed co-planning for targeted, standards-based Math instruction.
- Include ESE teachers in weekly Math PLCs to align specialized and core instruction.
- Monitor IEP and assessment data to adjust accommodations and interventions.

SIP AREAS OF FOCUS



POSITIVE BEHAVIORAL INTERVENTIONS & SUPPORTS

Measurable Outcome: Reduce discipline referrals by 5%, from 1,370 to 1,300 or fewer, to maximize classroom instructional time.

Action Steps:

- Reinforce schoolwide expectations through PBIS assemblies and recognition.
- Provide PBIS incentives through weekly and quarterly reward opportunities.
- Review discipline data weekly to provide targeted Tier 2/3 behavioral support.



STUDENT ATTENDANCE & TRUANCY INTERVENTION

Measurable Outcome: Increase daily attendance by 3% and reduce the number of chronically absent students from 250.

Action Steps:

- Review attendance data bi-weekly to identify emerging truancy patterns.
- Provide proactive family outreach and connect families with support resources.
- Assign adult mentors for regular check-ins, goal tracking, and student connectedness.
