SIP AREAS OF FOCUS



ELA ACHIEVEMENT (GRADES 3-5)

Measurable Outcome: Increase FAST ELA proficiency across Grades 3–5 by 3 percentage points, from 80% to 83%.

Action Steps:

- Meet weekly in PLTs to identify essential standards, skill gaps, and targeted instruction.
- Provide data-driven remediation while maintaining Tier 1 grade-level instruction.
- Monitor CSA data and student goals through regular administrative and Guiding Coalition participation.



ELA LOWEST 25% LEARNING GAINS

Measurable Outcome: Increase Reading Learning Gains for Lowest 25th Percentile students in Grades 4–5 by 3 percentage points, from 54% to 57%.

Action Steps:

- Use FAST data to identify specific literacy gaps in Lowest 25% students.
- Provide spiral review and targeted reteaching during intervention blocks.
- Use student goal-setting conferences to monitor progress toward learning gains.



STUDENT ATTENDANCE & POSITIVE CULTURE

Measurable Outcome: Reduce chronic absenteeism by 3 percentage points, from 9.16% to 6.16% or lower.

Action Steps:

- Review attendance monthly and use 2x10 mentoring for at-risk students.
- Recognize consistent attendance through schoolwide displays and celebrations.
- Use Kagan structures to strengthen engagement, classroom community, and school connectedness.



CELEBRATIONS & SUCCESSES

Improving Math scores was PES' focus for the 25-26 school year. The lowest 25% of our 4th and 5th graders went from 39% to 71% level 3 and above. In the area of Math Learning Gains, our school went from 54% to 77% level 3 and above. Overall, Math achievement for our 3rd, 4th and 5th graders went from 77% to 87% in one year's time.
