SIP AREAS OF FOCUS



READING LEARNING GAINS

Measurable Outcome: Increase K-2 Reading Learning Gains from 89% to 91% and 3-8 Reading Learning Gains from 73% to 76%.

Action Steps:

- Engage in systematic PLC cycles to analyze data, set team SMART goals, and implement targeted instructional responses.
- Utilize MTSS Core Team to review Tier I literacy data and recommend interventions.
- Monitor progress via Model PLC Guiding Coalition and FAST Progress Monitoring.



MATHEMATICS LEARNING GAINS

Measurable Outcome: Increase K-2 Math Learning Gains from 86% to 88% and 3-8 Math Learning Gains from 78% to 80%.

Action Steps:

- Analyze FAST and standards-based data in PLCs to set team SMART goals.
- MTSS Core Team to evaluate core instruction and identify barriers to success.
- Implement differentiated instruction and targeted interventions based on diagnostic data.



STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES (SWD) GROWTH

Measurable Outcome: Increase SWD Reading Learning Gains from 52% to 55% and Math Learning Gains from 63% to 66%.

Action Steps:

- Collaborative planning between general education and ESE teachers in PLCs.
- MTSS Core Team to regularly review SWD performance data and intervention effectiveness.
- Utilize diagnostic assessments (DRA/QRI) for targeted small-group support.

- Provide professional learning focused on mathematics acceleration.

STUDENT ATTENDANCE

Measurable Outcome: Increase average daily attendance from 93% to 94% and reduce chronic absenteeism by 10%.

- MTSS Core Team to review data and develop targeted interventions for chronic absenteeism.
- Collaborate with families to address barriers to attendance.
