STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES (SWD) LEARNING GAINS

Measurable Outcome: Increase SWD performance by 5 percentage points across ELA Achievement, ELA Learning Gains, Math Achievement, and Science Achievement.

Action Steps:

- Provide targeted SWD small-group instruction using data, scaffolding, and explicit feedback.
- Analyze SWD data bi-weekly to adjust groups and interventions.
- Monitor implementation and student growth through monthly leadership and ESE reviews.



MIDDLE SCHOOL MATHEMATICS ACCELERATION

Measurable Outcome: Increase Middle School Acceleration from 89% to at least 90%, while increasing SWD participation beyond 64%.

Action Steps:

- Identify and place eligible students in high-school-credit acceleration pathways.
- Provide targeted academic support and progress monitoring for accelerated students.
- Review subgroup participation quarterly to ensure equitable access and success.



STUDENT ATTENDANCE & POSITIVE CULTURE

Measurable Outcome: Reduce discipline referrals by 10% and repeat suspensions by 15%, while improving daily attendance.

Action Steps:

- Use EWS to provide timely, personalized family communication.
- Develop attendance plans for students missing 10% of days.
- Assign staff mentors for regular check-ins, goal setting, and positive reinforcement.
