SIP AREAS OF FOCUS



STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES (SWD) GROWTH

Measurable Outcome: Increase SWD ELA Learning Gains from 61% to at least 64% and SWD Math Learning Gains from 55% to at least 58%.

Action Steps:

- Use weekly PLCs to analyze data and plan targeted small-group support.
- Strengthen ESE/Gen Ed collaboration to embed standards-aligned scaffolds and accommodations.
- Use FAST and MTSS data to guide reteaching and adjust interventions.



DIFFERENTIATED INSTRUCTION & ACHIEVEMENT

Measurable Outcome: Increase overall achievement in ELA from 81% to 84%+, Math from 81% to 84%+, and Science from 74% to 77%+ across grades K-7.

Action Steps:

- Use PLCs to align Tier 1 instruction with B.E.S.T. standards and monitor mastery.
- Provide flexible small groups, targeted L25 interventions, and enrichment.
- Use walkthroughs and FAST data reviews to adjust instruction and resources.



MIDDLE SCHOOL ACCELERATION

Measurable Outcome: Increase Middle School Acceleration rate from the 81% historical baseline to at least 90%, meeting the SJCSO district goal.

Action Steps:

- Review eligibility, placement, and performance data quarterly to identify acceleration candidates.
- Provide targeted support and intervention for accelerated students.
- Monitor course completion quarterly to ensure student success.

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POSITIVE BEHAVIORAL INTERVENTIONS & SUPPORTS

Measurable Outcome: Achieve 100% implementation of SOAR expectations across classrooms; ensure 80%+ favorable student climate survey responses regarding safety and connectedness.

Action Steps:

- Teach and reinforce SOAR expectations schoolwide
- Recognize positive behavior through PBIS rewards and recognition.
- Review behavior and climate data monthly to adjust supports and reteach expectations.



STUDENT ATTENDANCE & TRUANCY PREVENTION

Measurable Outcome: Reduce the percentage of students absent 10%+ of school days from 8.3% baseline to 5.3% or lower.

Action Steps:

- Monitor attendance through EWS data, focusing on Grades 5-7.
- Implement tiered attendance interventions, family outreach, and student support.
- Review attendance trends quarterly to evaluate and adjust interventions



CELEBRATIONS & SUCCESSSES

Highlight key achievements, recognitions, programs, and milestones.

- Inaugural Year Milestone: Successfully opened Sabal Crest Academy as a new K-7 school community, establishing the systems, traditions, and shared identity that will shape SCA for years to come.
- SOAR & PBIS: Launched a schoolwide PBIS program centered on Show Respect, Own Your Learning, Act Safely, and Rise with Resilience, creating a common culture and recognition system for all students.
- Collaborative Learning Systems: Established collaborative PLC structures focused on standards-aligned instruction, student data, targeted intervention, enrichment, and continuous improvement.
- Family & Community Partnership: Established strong partnerships with families and the community through SAC, PTO, family engagement opportunities, and ongoing stakeholder feedback to help shape SCA during its inaugural year.
