SIP AREAS OF FOCUS



INSTRUCTIONAL PRACTICE (ELA, MATH, SCIENCE)

Measurable Outcome: Increase FAST ELA proficiency to 82% (+2%), FAST Math proficiency to 85% (+2%), Science proficiency to 79% (+2%), and Grade 3 Reading proficiency to 84% (+3%).

Action Steps:

- Build a strong leadership coalition to guide instructional improvement.
- Strengthen high-yield practices through coaching, feedback, and PLC learning.
- Implement targeted math interventions and ELA enrichment to address learning gaps.



MIDDLE SCHOOL ACCELERATION

Measurable Outcome: Achieve and maintain an ambitious middle school mathematics acceleration rate of 90%.

Action Steps:

- Automatically place qualifying students in accelerated math beginning in grade 6.
- Use PSAT 8/9 data to monitor high school math readiness.
- Provide targeted reteaching through support blocks and common assessments before EOCs.



STUDENT ATTENDANCE & PBIS CULTURE

Measurable Outcome: Increase student attendance by 3%, reduce chronic absenteeism (10%+ days absent), and improve school climate and student connectedness measures.

Action Steps:

- Embed "The TCA Way" through PBIS, clear expectations, and positive reinforcement.
- Monitor attendance and behavior data to provide proactive interventions.
- Strengthen family and community engagement through workshops, PTO, and community partnerships.



CELEBRATIONS & SUCCESSES

Highlight key achievements, recognitions, programs, and milestones.

- 100% of students passed the Algebra 1 and Geometry EOC in both 2025 and 2026.
- 96% of students passed the Civics EOC in 2026.
- 92% of staff retention rate since the school opened.
- TCA received grant monies to target third grade and middle school math students.
