COLLABORATIVE PLANNING

Measurable Outcome: Improve overall student proficiency by 2% on subject-specific state assessments.

Action Steps:

- Engage PLCs in continuous data-driven improvement cycles: set SMART goals, identify essential benchmarks, and build common formative/summative assessments.
- Utilize GradeCam to attach assessment items to standards for precise tracking, targeted remediation, and enrichment.
- Conduct student data discussions, goal setting, and progress tracking.



STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES (SWD)

Measurable Outcome: SWD subgroup learning gains will increase from 49% to 51% in ELA and Mathematics.

Action Steps:

- Use progress monitoring data to track essential standards and design small-group remediation and extensions.
- Collaborate between ESE Support Facilitators and general education teachers in PLCs to deliver targeted small-group instruction and Toro Time interventions.
- Differentiate professional development for teachers through PLCs.
