SIP AREAS OF FOCUS



SCIENCE PROFICIENCY & ACHIEVEMENT

Measurable Outcome: Increase overall Science Achievement by 4 percentage points, from 76% to 80% on state assessments.

Action Steps:

- Use PLC data reviews to identify Science standards requiring targeted reteaching.
- Monitor instruction to ensure essential standards are taught with fidelity.
- Use district curriculum maps to spiral and reinforce Science standards across grade levels.



STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES (SWD) MATH GAINS

Measurable Outcome: Increase Math Learning Gains for SWD from 71% to at least 75% on state assessments.

Action Steps:

- Provide targeted small-group Math instruction using iReady and EnVision resources.
- Review assessment and IEP data regularly to adjust SWD supports.
- Align SDI and IEP goals with Tier 1 Math standards to close achievement gaps.



POSITIVE BEHAVIORAL INTERVENTIONS & SUPPORTS

Measurable Outcome: Reduce out-of-school suspension days by at least 3%, from 96 to 90 days or fewer across Grades K-8.

Action Steps:

- Use monthly PBIS meetings to reinforce "The VRA Way".
- Review discipline data regularly to identify/address behavioral needs.
- Implement and celebrate PBIS incentives to strengthen positive behavior and engagement.



STUDENT ATTENDANCE & CHRONIC ABSENTEEISM

Measurable Outcome: Reduce chronic absenteeism by at least 3%, from 106 to 102 students or fewer.

Action Steps:

- Review attendance data monthly to identify students at risk of chronic absenteeism.
- Provide personalized family outreach and attendance support plans.
- Assign adult mentors to support attendance through regular check-ins and encouragement.



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EXCELLENCE IN PUBLIC EDUCATION
