SIP AREAS OF FOCUS



MATHEMATICS INSTRUCTION & LEARNING GAINS

Measurable Outcome: Increase Math Learning Gains from 42% to 55% in Grade 4 and from 38% to 50% in Grade 5.

Action Steps:

- Use weekly PLCs to align standards, rigor, and problem-solving instruction.
- Analyze data regularly to create flexible groups for targeted reteaching and tutoring.
- Use daily math fluency and formative assessments to monitor skill mastery.



EARLY LITERACY & READING PROFICIENCY (RAISE)

Measurable Outcome: Increase reading proficiency to 55% in Grade 2, 60% in Grade 3, 61% in Grade 4, and 65% in Grade 5, with 60% learning gains in Grades 4–5.

Action Steps:

- Implement Benchmark and Foundations to strengthen Science of Reading-aligned instruction.
- Use diagnostic data to provide targeted, skill-based reading interventions
- Provide weekly literacy coaching, modeling, and PLC support.



STUDENT ATTENDANCE & CHRONIC ABSENTEEISM

Measurable Outcome: Reduce schoolwide chronic absenteeism from 15.87% to 12% or lower.

Action Steps:

- Review attendance data weekly to identify and support at-risk students.
- Implement weekly “Check and Connect” mentoring and family partnerships.
- Evaluate attendance trends quarterly and adjust interventions as needed.
